Updates & Reminders:

In light of our recent event – “The Tornado Watch” the management team has reviewed our procedures. It was certainly a learning experience.

Recommendations for future “Tornado Watches”

It is not classed as a “CODE GREEN” (evacuation) rather a “CODE GREY” (shelter in place) as we do not evacuate the building – however it is moving people within our building.

In the estate when the announcement is made (if we have time)

- 1) The staff will take an estate census sheet and go room to room to advise residents that we are under a watch
- 2) close all windows & blinds – DO NOT stand on your patio & watch the storm – move away from the windows – flying debris often causes injury
- 3) the bathroom is the safest place – hallways where there is no glass are also safer

We were offering residents to sit in the lounge downstairs but in the event that the power would go out, if you cannot navigate the stairs you will have to remain on the main floor throughout. The lounge is not the safest area as there are large windows in that space – rather the hallway - rule of thumb – put as many walls between you & the outside.

We were very fortunate that the storm blew over but it is important to know what to do in the event that the tornado had touched down.
